There will be multiple radios available for scout participation in this Event.

Activities:

Scouts use a radio to make a **QSO** (QSO is a contact with another station) and record it on a paper log
View/read amateur radio magazines (many copies will be available to take home)

View **QSL** cards (post cards from other operators which confirm the date/time of their **QSO**)

Phonetic alphabet introduction (**Alpha, Bravo, Charlie, Delta, Echo, Foxtrot, Golf, Hotel.....**)

Introduction to **Q-codes** 3 letter codes such as a **QSO** = a contact with another radio operator on the air

Discuss the various FCC license levels available and the ease of becoming a Technician licensee

Presentations will occur throughout the day on topics such as emergency/disaster communications, amateur radio mesh networks, building a working antenna out of wire, repeaters and other topics.
